Abnormal load fees 2009

It is one of the basic functions of the Abnormal Loads Technical Committee to recommend the fees relating to exemption permits. For obvious considerations of credibility and efficiency, fees should be uniform, and calculated and applied by all provinces.

The proposed fees are set to optimise the income derived by the provincial governments based on actual scientifically determined costs and indexed to the Producer Price Index (PPI).
